Fireworks displays at 9.30 and 12, sausage sizzle, kids activities including face painting and a giant slide and a free gift bag for kids from 7pm

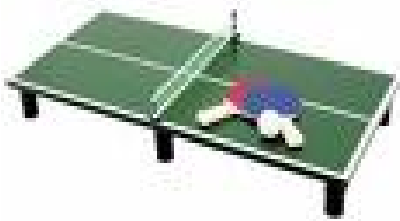
#### Jazz on the Greens @ The Hawks Nest Golf Club
